## Frequently Asked Questions with Packing Suggestions

### **I see that Camp Providence is affiliated with the Methodist Church.**

#### **What if my family isn't Methodist?**

No problem at all. We are certainly a faith-based camp, but our Christian summer curriculum is open and welcoming to all. Our day camp is so much fun that even if your child has yet to come to faith, they will have a blast. We believe the personal exploration of faith is a vital part of our mission and in this area, you and your child can expect each day to include group worship, daily themes that integrate into the daily activities and small group devotions.

#### **How do I register for day camp?**

You can register for day camp via our [Asbury Hills registration portal](#). Just select the day camp option and you can start the process. When you complete the registration, your spot is reserved.

#### **Does everyone do every activity?**

Day campers will have the opportunity to do every activity over the course of their time at Camp Providence. Our staff are trained to encourage campers to try new things. We do try to get kids out of their comfort zone for them to challenge themselves and grow. We don't however force them to do an activity if the child really is uncomfortable with it.

#### **Can my camper bring a friend?**

Part of coming to camp is making new friends. At the same time, if your camper wants to attend with a friend, they are welcome to register for the same week of day camp. We will do our best to accommodate.

#### **What should my camper bring every day?**

We suggest all day campers bring the following items every day: water bottle, rain jacket or poncho, towel, bathing suit, backpack to hold everything and a lunch.

We do not have access to refrigerators or microwaves so their lunch should be something that won't require refrigeration or heating up. We do not recommend bringing electronics to day camp. We are not responsible for any damaged or lost personal items while the camper is at Camp Providence.

#### **When is the full payment due for day camp?**

The full payment is due prior to arrival to Camp Providence for your camper's week of camp.

#### **What is the day camp cancellation policy?**

To cancel your week of day camp, please contact our Reservation Specialist at 864.836.3711. The following guidelines apply to refunds:

- In all cases, an attempt to is made to reschedule the camper to another week.
- For cancellations up to 30 days prior to camp, the refund will be the amount paid less \$35
- There will be no refunds or cancellations within 30 days of the week of camp, but funds will go towards camper scholarships.

#### **Can my camper arrive early or late to camp?**

If you know in advance that your camper will be arriving later or earlier than normal to camp, please contact our office via phone or [email](#) and let us know the camper's name, that they are a day camper and the planned time of arrival. If you are stuck in traffic please call 864.836.3711. If we are unable to answer your call, please leave a message with your camper's name, that they are day camper and the estimated time of arrival. Transportation for early or late arrival must be provided by the parent or guardian.

#### **My camper left something behind. Do you have it?**

If we find something that is labeled with your camper's name, we will do our best to get it back to you. We encourage all of your camper's items to be labeled. All items that aren't labeled will be donated after 14 days.

#### **What if my camper takes medications or has allergies?**

All medications are collected by a member of our staff during check-in. All medications should be in their original containers and clearly labeled with the camper's name. During the week, our staff ensure that campers receive their medications at the correct time.

#### **Do you have a bus?**

We do have a bus for transportation. This information will be available when your camper's week of camp gets closer. We are working with local churches to serve as drop off locations. If your church is interested in serving as a drop off or pick up location, please [let us know!](#)
